The *USAID Informal Livelihoods Advancement Activity "Iqlaa"*, is a five-year USAID-funded program that aims to support Jordan's Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) to grow, transform, and become resilient to future shocks. Mercy Corps leads on the implementation of Iqlaa and the Middle East Investment Initiative (MEII) is one of its implementation partners. Under Iqlaa, MEII will implement "Tamweeli Academy", a hybrid training on accounting and financial literacy to enhance business management skills.
